## BIBLE STUDY SYMBOLS.

Bible study can be done in different ways. One way is to use symbols to immediately be able to see what a certain passage is all about. It is also a way to remember what has been learned in that passage and not loose that insight. Another advantage of using symbols is that it keeps one alert at all times - while listening to a sermon, doing a Bible study or in one's quiet time and all you need is a pencil or pen. It takes just a little practice and time to build it into your lifestyle, but once used to it you will not want to do without. As the symbols act as keys, incorporating them in your Bible study will help open up the Scriptures to you.

The symbols used below have been developed over a period of many years as I got into the Word of God. Please feel free to use them, change them or add to them as you please. What is important is how it works for you. Basically I have used the alphabet and symbols that were logical to me. Here an explanation of some of the symbols:

- " Creation is a "C" in the process of becoming a circle for the world.
- \* \*F' = for faith. Sin or non-faith is an 'F' upside down.
- \* Giving = a coin with a °G' in it for God.
- \* Glorifying = 2 hands lifted with some shout lines in the middle.
- \* A triangle is used for God, illustrating the trinity. A letter inside it refers to a specific aspect.
- \* Marriage is a heart with a line through it, making the top half into an 'M'.
- \* Christ's return is symbolized by an 'M' with an arrow pointing down for Maranatha or an arrow that comes down and up again, taking another arrow with it. (Representing the rapture)
- \* Persecution is a circle for the world and an arrow down for pressure or pressing down.
- \* Relationships = 2 'R's next to each other.
- \* An'S' laid on it's side is a sacrifice.

God bless you as you use these symbols making you more aware of all He says. May they help to make your Bible reading and studying even more meaningful and joyful. Remember that hearing God speak and knowing His desires is more important than praying, for how can you pray if you don't know God's heart.
